

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF STONE MILLS

BEING A BY-LAW TO PROHIBIT THE PARKING OR LEAVING OF MOTOR VEHICLES WITHIN THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF STONE MILLS.

WHEREAS it is considered desirable for the adequate control of parking and leaving of motor vehicles on private or municipal property within the defined area of the Township of Stone Mills to prohibit the parking and leaving of said motor vehicles:

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Stone Mills, pursuant to its powers under Section 210.124 of the Municipal Act R.S.O. 1990, c. M 45, enacts as follows:

1. From the first day of December in any year until the fifteenth day of April of the following year no person shall park or leave a motor vehicle on private property without authority from the owner or occupant of such property.
2. From the first day of December in any year until the fifteenth day of April of the following year no person shall park or leave a motor vehicle on property of the municipality or any local board thereof where parking by the public is not authorized
3. Any vehicle parked or left on property in violation of sections one (1) and two (2), may be removed and impounded at the expense of the owner thereof.
4. Every person who contravenes this By-law is guilty of an offence punishable on summary conviction and shall be liable to a fine not less than seventy-five dollars (\$75.00) if paid to the Township Treasurer during business hours within seven (7) regular days of the contravention of this By-law, or in default of such payment, shall be liable to a fine of not less than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for each offence;
And, in addition, such person shall be liable for any towing and storage charges related to the removal of any vehicle for the purposes of snow removal.
5. The driver of a motor vehicle, not being the owner, is liable to the penalty prescribed in Section Four (4) and the owner is also liable to such penalty. Unless at the time the offence was committed the motor vehicle was in the possession of a person other than the owner without the owner's consent.
6. The driver or owner of a motor vehicle parked or left on private property is not liable to a penalty or to have the motor vehicle removed from such property or impounded except upon the written complaint of the owner or occupant of the property.
7. This By-law comes into full force and effect on the date of passing.
8. All other by-laws conflicting with this By-law are hereby repealed.

Read a first and second time this Seventh day of December, 1998.

Read a third time and finally passed this Seventh day of December, 1998.
