

CENTENNIAL PARK

GUIDING PRINCIPLES AND OBJECTIVES:

This policy outlines the guiding principles for Centennial Park and the approach the Township of Stone Mills undertakes to achieve these objectives.

The guiding principles of this policy are to encourage outdoor activities for residents within the Township of Stone Mills;

In order to achieve these objectives, the Township shall provide open space for the youth and adults to walk, run, play and interact;

RATES:

Daily rate per family \$ 3.00

Boat Launch per day \$10.00

RULES:

1. All visitors and picnickers must register to the Park Custodians Office.
2. All dogs must be on a leash at all times.
3. Maximum Speed Limit, 15 kilometers per hour.
4. Unlicensed motor vehicles are prohibited.
5. Gates will be locked at dusk.
6. All boats and water skiers must stay at least 100 feet away from the swimming area.
7. All boats must be operated in accordance with Provincial boating regulation.
8. There shall be NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.
9. No horseplay on beach, dock, public drinking water supply areas or in the washroom facilities.
10. Persons under the age of eighteen years of age shall have parental supervision at all times.

The above rules have been endorsed by the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Stone Mills and authority given to the Custodian to enforce them.

Please be respectful of the property and be respectful to others who are visiting.

Any person disregarding any of these rules shall be asked to leave quietly without financial reimbursement as applicable.

Information To All Visitors:

During July and August, the Township arranges for a Swim Program at the established beach area. It is anticipated that fifty (50) children and supervisors will be visiting through these months.
