Terms of Reference

The Township of Stone Mills Recreation Volunteer Program is a community awards and recognition program, coordinated and sponsored yearly by the Township of Stone Mills. The purpose of these awards is to recognize worthy individuals in the Township of Stone Mills for their consistent contributions to the overall quality of life in Stone Mills Township.

Duration/Frequency of the Awards

The Township of Stone Mills' Volunteer Awards Night is held annually. There are FOUR awards categories which are as follows:

- (a) Volunteer Youth (under the age of 19) of the Year
- (b) Volunteer Group (2 or more persons) of the Year
- (c) Volunteer Senior (over the age of 60) of the Year
- (d) Volunteer Citizen (between the ages of 19 and 60) of the Year

One award will be given out yearly for each category to a nominated volunteer.

An individual or group can only receive one award per category in their lifetime.

Award

Winners will receive an award at a special reception at the Centreville Municipal Hall. Families and friends will be invited to attend a social on Thursday, January 22, 2009. Awards will be given out the same evening by rotating members of the Council of the Township of Stone Mills.

Eligibility

Only residents of the Township of Stone Mills will be eligible for an award.

The volunteer awards will be given out for any reason appropriate by the Committee as appointed.

The following are areas of consideration for all the volunteer awards: Educational Excellence, Senior Volunteerism, General Volunteerism, Excellence in Sports, Community Beautification, Environmental Contributions, Culture Enrichment, Entrepreneurship and Rural Contribution.
