
**Policy for Roadside
Litter Pick-Up by Residents**

Between April 15th and May 30th in any given year residents who provide roadside litter pick-up will be supplied ten free bags.

Residents must pick-up free bags and sign for them giving road name and location of where litter pick-up will occur.

With the demand on road personnel it will be impossible for pick-up by township employees so it will be the responsibility of the residents to deliver litter collected to the landfills.

The municipality is trying hard to keep recyclables from landfill; residents who are picking up roadside debris should when ever possible have recyclables in separate bags.

When bags are delivered to the landfill sites the residents must give their name and how many garbage bags from roadside pick-up that is being deposited to landfill.

When residents come across old couches, chairs, tires or refuse that they cannot handle they should call Township Road Department at 613.378.1435 and leave a message giving location and brief description of waste and crew will respond as time permits.
