Regular Meeting of Council for May 25, 2026

Items for Consideration

Extension of Approval of Draft Plan of Subdivision, Warner Pasture

The applicant for the Warner Pasture Subdivision requested an extension of the draft approval for the plan of subdivision with File Number 11-T-07-001, Warner Pasture, for a period of one (1) year, to July 14, 2027 to continue to clear conditions. Council received the [Staff Report](#) and approved the extension.

Respect Conduct Policy

Staff introduced a new policy for the Council's consideration, aiming to create a distinct and documented framework for identifying, addressing, and managing instances of unreasonable behavior directed at Township employees. Council provided feedback on the draft policy and requested clearer definitions with respect to what constituted unreasonable behaviour. Naturally L&A Gravel Ride - 2026 Special Event Permit

Council received a [Staff Report](#) outlining the Special Event Permit request for this year's annual Naturally L&A Gravel Ride to be held June 6, 2026. [The Naturally L&A Gravel Ride](#) is an annual 53-kilometre cycling event through the rural countryside of Stone Mills Township. Starting and finishing at A Good Farm in Centreville, the route follows a mix of asphalt and gravel roads, crossing the Salmon River and passing through Tamworth, Croydon, Enterprise, and Centreville. Six rest stops feature local food, live music, and producers from across the township. The permit was approved by Council.

Royal Canadian Legion Branch 458 - D-Day Special Event Permit

Council received a request from the Tamworth Legion to host a D-Day Special Event on June 6th. This year marks the 82nd anniversary of D-Day and the Tamworth Legion will also be celebrating the Royal Canadian Legion's 100th anniversary. Council received a [Staff Report](#) outlining the event details and approved the request.

Letter of Request from Lisa Ross-Black

Lisa Ross-Black, Treasurer/Secretary for the Royal Canadian Legion Branch 458 and Treasurer for the Tamworth and District Lions Club submitted a letter requesting various items related to fees and charges for tables and chairs at Township facilities. Council agreed to waive the \$1000 setup fee for events on June 6th and August 23rd. Staff will assess inventory and budget impacts for purchasing additional tables and chairs for each Township facility to accommodate permitted occupancy and additionally will monitor feedback regarding the Fees and Charges By-law and website content. Province of Ontario's New "Bring-Your-Own" (BYOB) Alcoholic Beverages for Event

A Staff Report entitled "[Province of Ontario's New "Bring-Your-Own" \(BYOB\) Alcoholic Beverages for Events](#)" was presented to Council providing an update on Provincial amendments to the Liquor Licence and Control Act, 2019 regulations. Council directed staff not to proceed with developing municipal by-laws or policies to permit BYOB at this time and requested staff communicate with the public outlining the framework.

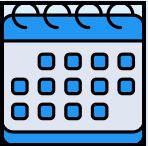
