## **Review of Special Event By-law**

At the Regular Council meeting of June 16, 2025 Council passed a Resolution (5-691-2025) directing staff to review the existing Special Event Permit Policy. A report entitled "Review of Special Event By-law" was received at the November 3, 2025 Regular Council meeting and staff were directed to incorporate proposed changes into the Special Events By-law and bring back at a future meeting.

## **Beaver Lake Disposition Update**

A Staff Report entitled "Beaver Lake Disposition Update" was presented to Council highlighting Infrastructure Ontario's (IO) intent to dispose of the Beaver Lake property. The property is going through a multi-stage circulation process with provincial ministries and municipalities. The Township will have an opportunity to express interest in purchasing the property when it becomes available.

## Ratti Road

Council deferred the Staff Report entitled "Ratti Road" which addressed the recurring flooding on Ratti Road at the Mud Creek Crossing which has caused significant damage. The report will be brought back at the November 17, 2025 Council meeting for consideration.
