



### **FIBRES – Blue Box Recyclables – Paper, Cardboard, Boxboard**

- ✓ Newspapers, flyers (glossy or plain)
- ✓ Magazines, catalogues, telephone books, soft covered books, greeting cards
- ✓ Fine paper (writing, computer, envelopes, mail, sticky notes)
- ✓ Paper bags (grocery, potato, flour, sugar)
- ✓ Boxboard - cereal, cracker, cookies boxes, shoe boxes, tissue boxes, medicine boxes, cosmetic boxes, file folders, laundry detergent boxes, paper egg cartons, empty toilet & paper towel rolls, pizza boxes, apple baskets, paper cups
- ✓ Cardboard & boxboard – flatten all boxes, bundle and tie in bundles no larger than **2 ft x 3ft**
- ✓ Be sure that loose materials will not blow away and create litter
- ✓ All recyclables must be clean

### **FIBRES – Not accepted in the Blue Box**

- ☒ No waxed or coated boxes, waxed food wrap, cookie bags, chip bags, dog food bags, ice cream cartons, frozen juice containers
- ☒ No photographs
- ☒ No plastic bags, vacuum sealed coffee bags
- ☒ No wrapping paper
- ☒ No Styrofoam
- ☒ No glass, cans, plastic
- ☒ No used tissue or paper towels

### **CONTAINERS – Blue Box Recyclables – Plastic, Metal, Glass Containers**

- ✓ Metal & aluminum food & beverage cans & containers
- ✓ Aluminum pie plates, rigid foil trays & foil
- ✓ Milk & juice cartons
- ✓ Glass containers – bottles & jars only
- ✓ Plastic containers – only plastics with a recycling symbol ♻️ (1, 2, 3, 4, 5 or 6)
  - eg. Bottles - pop, juice, water, laundry detergent, home cleaners, windshield washer fluid, vinegar, shampoo, lotion; Containers – margarine, yogurt, sour cream, etc
- ✓ Plastic bags (milk bags, frozen food bags (clear), bread bags, mattress bags, paper towel/toilet paper/diaper wrap, plastic grocery bags, bulk food bags)
- ✓ All recyclables must be clean

### **CONTAINERS – Not Accepted in the Blue Box**

- ☒ No motor oil bottles or pesticide bottles
- ☒ No light bulbs
- ☒ No window panes, mirrors, glass or ceramic dishes or clear prescription bottles
- ☒ No chip bags, straws
- ☒ No pots & pans, plastic toys, or plastic used to insulate windows
- ☒ no Styrofoam
- ☒ no paint cans or aerosol cans
- ☒ Reusable grocery bags (cloth or plastic)
