Regular Meeting of Council for May 11, 2026

Statutory Public Meeting

Zoning By-law Amendment Application-ZON2026-0001 (70 Galbraith Grove Rd)

This application relates to Consent Application B22-2024 which was provisionally approved November 21, 2024. The report entitled "[Zoning By-law Amendment Application – ZON2026-0001](#)" was received by Council proposing a portion of the property be rezoned from Rural 'RU' zone to Residential Limited Services 'RLS'. No comments from the public were received. Council passed a By-law to amend Zoning By-law 2014-744 subject to the Planning Act appeal period timeline.

Items for Consideration

CAO Performance Appraisal Process

Ann Rhodes, President of HR Management Services on Demand provided a presentation to Council relating to the Performance Appraisal process established by the Council working group. The presentation included an overview of the Performance Appraisal areas of review (Service, Work Habits and Behaviours and Attributes), Survey Questions for Council, Peers & External Stakeholders and Senior Management as well as rating grid. A [Staff Report](#) was presented to Council requesting approval of the Performance Appraisal and Development Plan framework and that the process be implemented. The proposed framework was approved by Council.

Newburgh Public School Council - Request for Donation

Staff received a request from the Newburgh Public School Council looking for donations towards their annual fun fair. A [Staff Report](#) was prepared providing Council donation options. Council agreed to donate a one hour PA Day ice rental, two (2) \$50 gift certificates to local businesses in Stone Mills, a pack of ten (10) garbage bags and a one day kayak rental at Centennial Park, valued at \$352.75 in total from the Council donation budget.

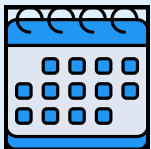
