### Regular Meeting of Council for June 22, 2026

#### Items for Consideration

##### **Rattie Road Update**

At the November 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2025 Council meeting, Council directed staff to repair a portion of Rattie Road to a preexisting condition. Through the permitting process, staff received communications from Quinte Conservation Authority (QCA) on June 8<sup>th</sup>, 2026 that an engineered design and hydraulic study would be required prior to construction. Council deferred the matter to a future Council meeting to allow staff to consult with Quinte Conservation regarding new requirements for additional studies. [Staff Report](#)

##### **Respectful Conduct Policy – Revised Draft for Approval**

A Respect Conduct Policy was presented to Council on May 20<sup>th</sup>, 2026 for consideration. Council requested some amendments to the draft policy, and it was brought back for approval. The policy can be viewed in the [Staff Report](#).

##### **Human Resources Updates - Beaver Lake Swim Program and New Positions**

Council was provided with an update on the recent hirings for the two swim instructor positions for the Beaver Lake Swim Program. Council was also updated on the two new position postings for a Recreation & Facilities Coordinator and Public Works Technician. ##### **2026 Budget Restatement**

Ontario Regulation 284/09 requires municipalities that have excluded certain expenses in the budgets to prepare a report about those excluded expenses and adopt the report by Council Resolution. The intent is to describe the conversion of the cash-based operating and capital budgets to a Public Sector Accounting Board (PSAB) budget compliant format. Council adopted the report and the approved 2026 Budget Reinstatement can be found within the [Staff Report](#).

##### **Canada Day Committee 2026 - Special Event Permit Application**

The [Tamworth Canada Day Committee](#) submitted a Special Event Permit application for their annual Canada Day event held in Tamworth. In addition to the application, the Committee also requested Township staff assistance in setting up the Soap Box Derby, supplying porta potties and event insurance coverage. Staff recommended approval of the Special Event Permit and the requests from the Canada Day Committee and also recommended approval of a Noise Exemption from 8:00 am to 10:30 pm. The staff recommendation was approved by Council and Council approved a donation amount with an upset limit of \$1,500.00 to support the event. [Staff Report](#)
