## Regular Meeting of Council for June 8, 2026

### Public Meeting

#### **Application to Permanently Close and Convey an Unopened Road Allowance – RC2026-01**

A Public meeting was held to receive comments on an application to stop-up and close a portion of the unopened, unmaintained municipal road allowance to allow for access to the parcel from Edges Road along the preexisting route in order to avoid disturbance to the existing wetland. There was no one in attendance to speak against this application, however there was one written comment provided by a neighboring property owner, who expressed interest in purchasing a portion abutting their lands if entitled to do so. Council directed staff to proceed in stopping up, closing, and conveying the portion of the unopened, unmaintained municipal road allowance located between Lot 18 of Concession 7 and Lot 18 of Concession 8, and that the portion of road allowance to be closed be dedicated to each of the adjacent property owners, where the owners are entitled to purchase a maximum of half of the road allowance abutting their lands. #### **Application to Permanently Close and Convey an Unopened Road Allowance – RC2026-02**

A Public meeting was held to receive comments on an application to the Township to stop-up and close the remnant part of Cedar Avenue. The purpose of this application is to clear up a title issue on the property known municipally as 44a Holly Lane. No comments were received from the public on this application and Council passed By-law 2026-1355 Being a By-law to stop up, close and convey the portion of the unopened, unmaintained municipal road allowance identified as Part 2 on Plan 29R-7858. #### **Stoney Steps Artsfest Special Event Permit**

Council received a delegation from the organizer of the [Stoney Steps Artsfest](#) event, which is scheduled for June 20, 2026. The organizer requested support from the Township to cover the insurance costs associated with hosting the event and requested the use of municipal picnic tables, garbage cans and garbage bags for the event. Upon review of the request, along with the Special Event Permit application, Council delegated authority to staff to issue a Special Event Permit and approved the requests from the event organizer, which will be funded by the Council donation budget. 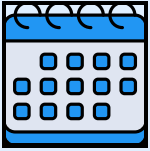
### **By-laws**
