## Notice of Motion/Direct Motion

- Following a Notice of Motion brought forward by Councillor Fenwick at the March 9<sup>th</sup> Council meeting, a motion was passed directing staff to bring back a report to Council regarding public education options and costing to educate the public on the burn by-law and other municipal by-laws.
- Councillor Milligan received Council support to make a Direct Motion requesting the Government of Canada complete a full federal Impact Assessment for the proposed ALTO High-Speed Rail Project, evaluate the option of developing rail along existing rail corridors and request the Government of Canada pause the advancement of the ALTO high-speed rail corridor provisions contained within Bill C-15 until full federal impact assessment is completed. This motion was passed unanimously by Council.
