



## **STONE MILLS RECREATION CENTRE - COVID-19 PROTOCOLS** **Effective Tuesday, October 5, 2021**

Please be advised that effective **Tuesday, October 5, 2021**, the Province of Ontario requires patrons to provide proof of full vaccination as well as identification (showing name and date of birth) before entering certain businesses and public settings.

**As of Tuesday, October 5, 2021, to enter the Stone Mills Recreation Centre (SMRC), users shall provide proof of full vaccination, along with identification that indicates your name and date of birth.** Some exemptions apply under certain circumstances, as stated below:

Vaccination Proof Required	Vaccination Proof <b>Not Required</b> <b>EXEMPTIONS</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Volunteers, Coaches and Officials</li><li>• 18+ (unless exempted)</li><li>• 18+ participating in Township programs (Senior Skate, Adult Skate, etc.)</li><li>• Parents or guardians of youth participating in organized sports</li><li>• Youth spectators (12-17), including attendance at sporting events</li><li>• Youth (12-17) not actively engaged in an organized sport (non-organized sport programs such as public skating and municipal run programs)</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Medical exemption (with documented proof from physician or by a registered nurse)</li><li>• Children under the age of 12</li><li>• Youth under 18 who are actively participating in an organized sport (sports leagues, organized sporting events)</li></ul>

The health and safety of all visitors to the Stone Mills Recreation Centre is of highest importance. To ensure a safe and positive experience, please treat everyone with respect when visiting the SMRC. People not following the protocols put in place will be required to leave the facility.
